the important points of a complex and new subject. However, I note that it is important to add interactive activities to

Keep participants' attention. In addition, I think a second visual support (e.g. summary sheet) would have been

useful for these three sessions.

Consideration of future strategies for managing similar sessions: I think for this type of presentation, a summary

sheet could be helpful for participants (to maintain their attention and to consult in the future if necessary).

In addition, for presentations on more complex concepts, I will add more interactive activities.
